
Disciples/Apostles of Jesus (KJV)

- 5 In Acts 1, the 11 cast lots and selected this man to replace Judas, though he was not the Lord's choice.
 (8)
- 6 In Matthew 10, Jesus gave the 12 disciples power against these fallen beings (2 wrds) (7,7)
- 10 This Apostle walked with Jesus on the water (5)
- 11 Jesus and His disciples were called to this event in Cana of Galilee. (8)
- 12 James, the son of this man, is always listed ninth in the List of Apostles. (8)
- 13 While Jesus was praying the night of His betrayal, He found the disciples in this state. (6)
- **14** In 3 of the 4 List of Apostles, this man is

- named after Philip (11)
- 17 Per Revelation 21, how many Apostles of the Lamb are there? (6)
- 18 This Apostle was a Canaanite (Black Man) (5)
- 19 Peter was also called this name per 1 Cor. 12. (6)

- 20 This Apostle was with Peter and John when Jesus was transfigured (5)
- 23 This king had James, the brother of John, killed (5)
- 24 After 3 years of being with Jesus, this Apostle asked Jesus to shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. (6)
- 25 In preparation of the passover, Jesus sent 2 disciples into the city to meet a man that would be bearing this, which was unusual. (3 wrds) (7,2,5)
- 27 This Apostle is referred to as the disciple whom Jesus loved. (4)
- **28** This Apostle was a publican. (7)
- 29 Thomas was also called this name (7)

- 1 Trying to defend Jesus, Peter cut off this man's right ear (7)
- 2 The Apostles and the rest of a group totally 120 were filled with the Holy Ghost on this Jewish holy day. (9)
- 3 This disciple, who was numbered with the twelve, never saw the resurrection of Jesus. (2 wrds) (5,8)

- 4 Jesus took Peter, James and John into this garden to pray the night of His betrayal. (10)
- 7 The occupation of Peter and Andrew per Matthew 4. (7)
- 8 This Apostle's last name was Thaddaeus (8)
- 9 This, the last Apostle, was also called Saul (4)
- 10 In Revelation 1, John was exiled to this island for preaching the Word of God (6)
- 15 When in the coast of Caesarea Philippi, Peter said that Jesus was ______, the Son of the living God. (2 wrds) (3,6)
- 16 James and John asked Jesus if He wanted them to command fire to come down from heaven and consume these people because they did not receive Jesus. (10)
- 21 When Jesus fed 5,000 men, besides the women and children, this Apostle told Jesus that a lad was there which had five barley loaves and two small fishes. (6)
- 22 In Matthew 26, when Jesus was arrested, all the disciples did this to Jesus, and fled. (7)
