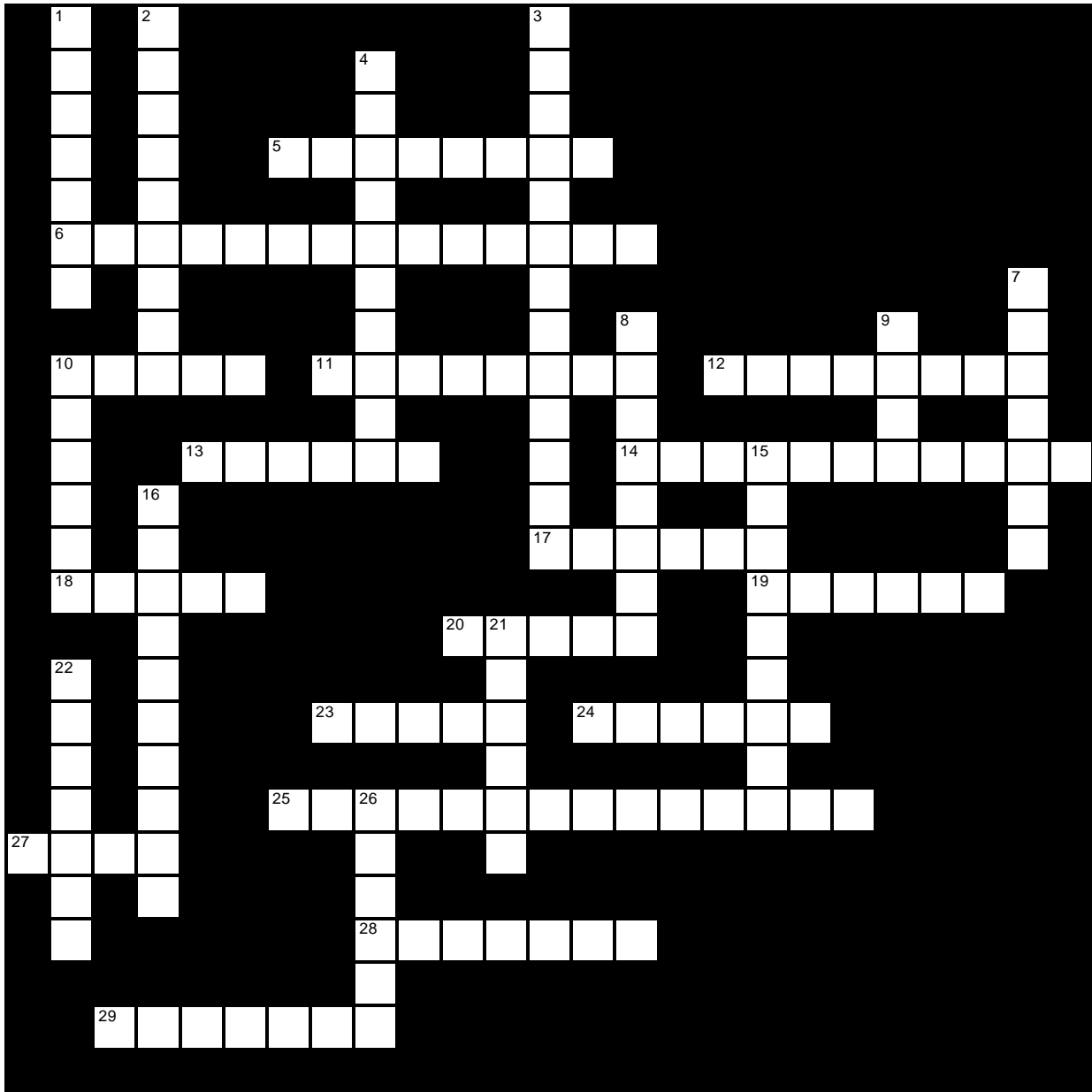


Disciples/Apostles of Jesus (KJV)

- 4** Jesus took Peter, James and John into this garden to pray the night of His betrayal. (10)
- 7** The occupation of Peter and Andrew per Matthew 4. (7)
- 8** This Apostle's last name was Thaddaeus (8)
- 9** This, the last Apostle, was also called Saul (4)
- 10** In Revelation 1, John was exiled to this island for preaching the Word of God (6)
- 15** When in the coast of Caesarea Philippi, Peter said that Jesus was _____, the Son of the living God. (2 wrds) (3,6)
- 16** James and John asked Jesus if He wanted them to command fire to come down from heaven and consume these people because they did not receive Jesus. (10)
