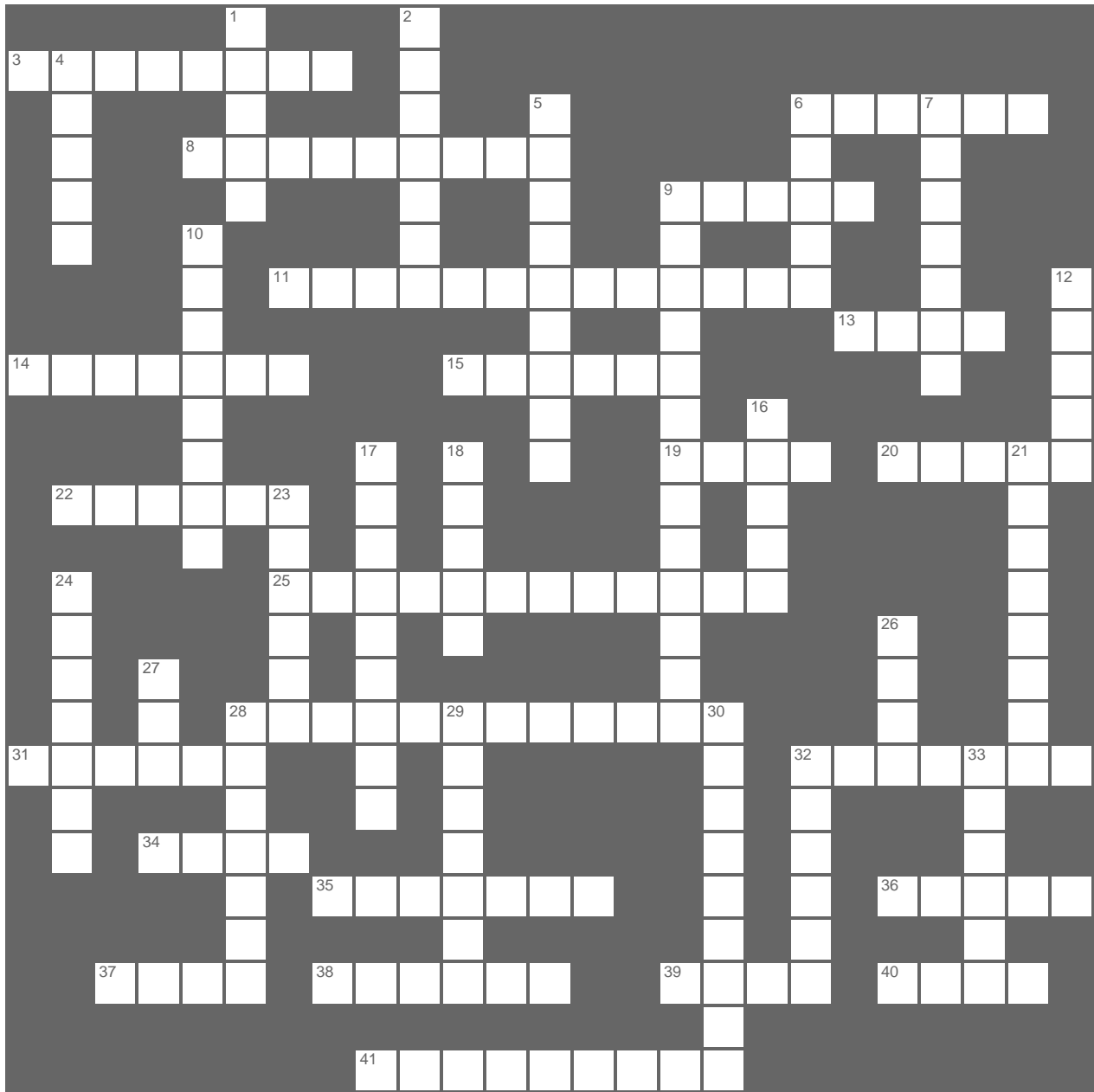


# John 12 (KJV)
