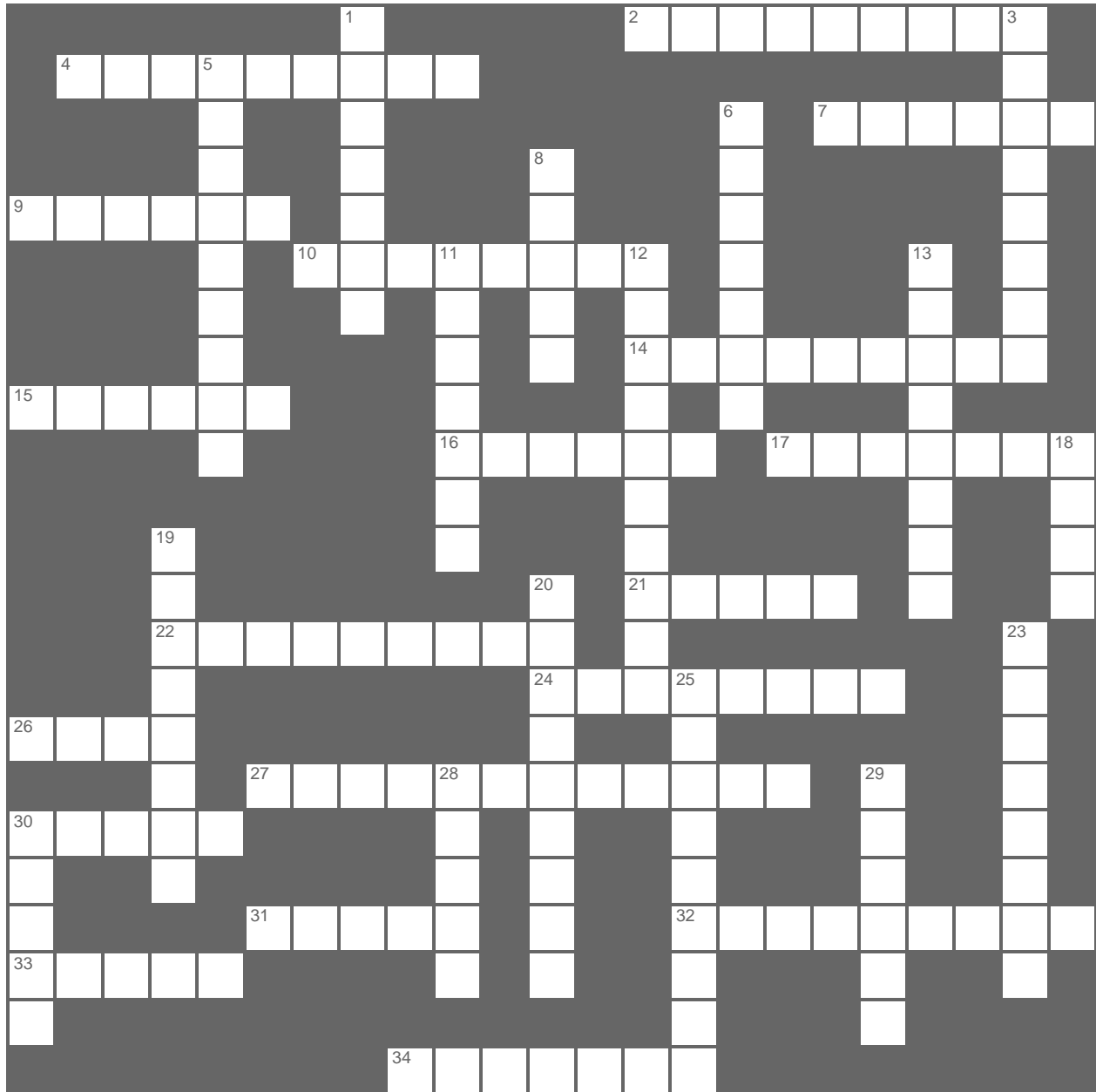


## Judges Chapter 19 (KJV)
