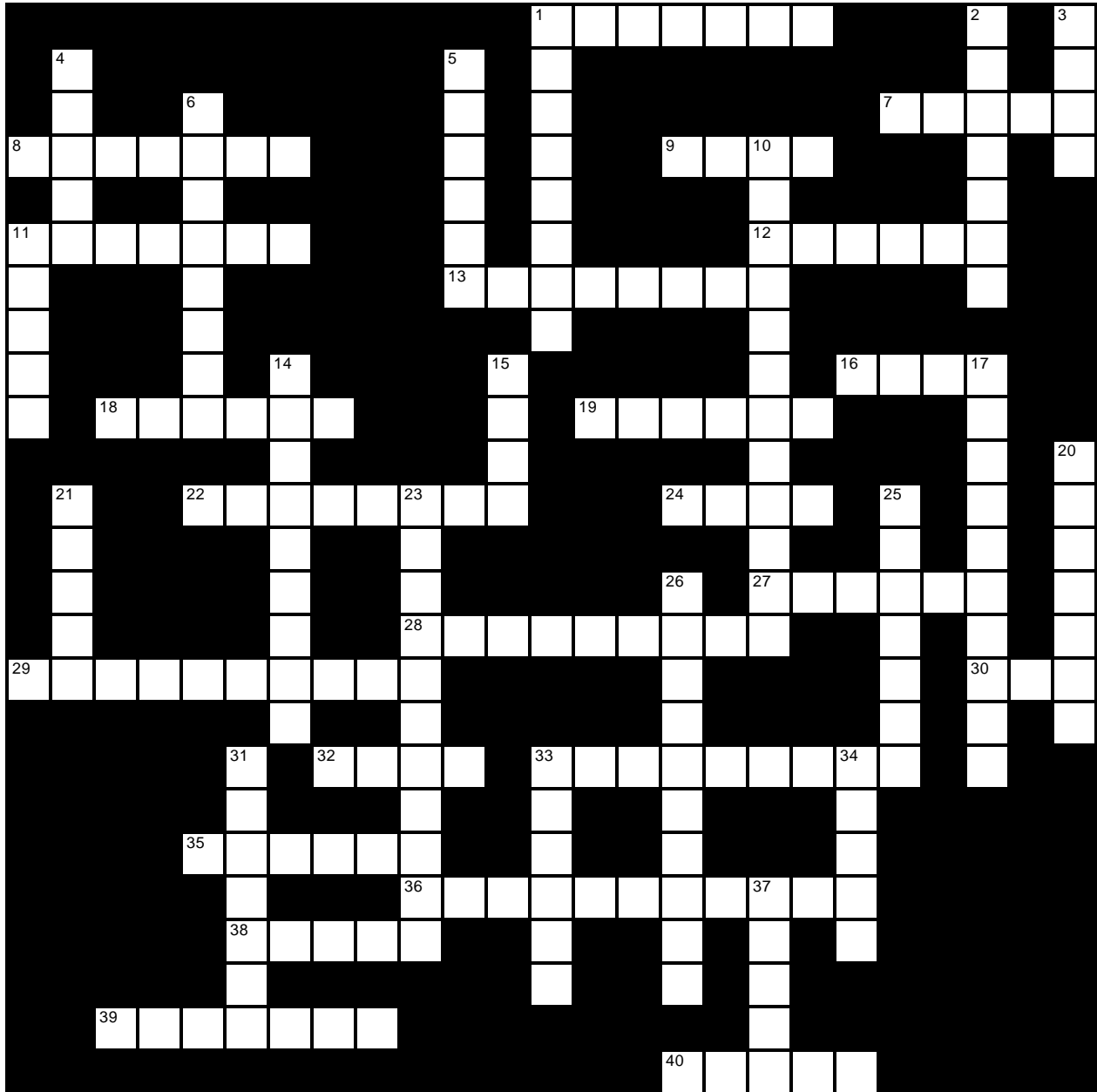


## The Ten Commandments Exodus Chapter 20 (KJV)
