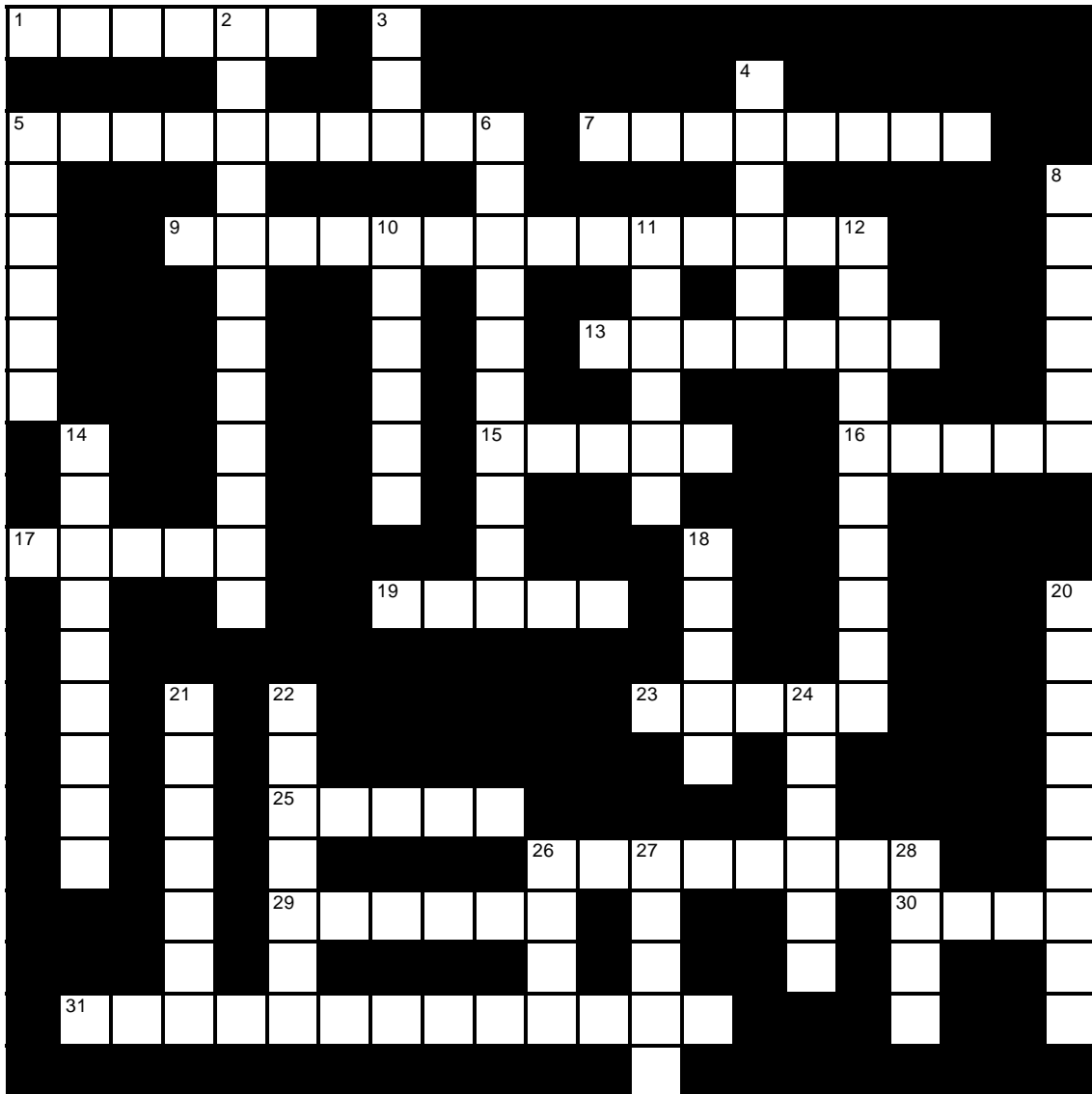


Who Said That (KJV)
